Trends in IT Compensation and Certifications

View from the Top

Money isn't everything, but it helps. Gone are the days of 70-hour weeks, but gone also are the bidding wars for IT staff and the lucrative job growth. IT has evolved further into a profession critical to a firm's financial success. According to the June 2006 CIO poll, the twelve-month spending plans overall are down from the previous quarter with FY07, but priorities have been assigned to addressing IT performance, business processes, innovation, and cost reduction.

As noted last quarter, it remains an employer's market for IT professionals. The CIO poll reported that 64.3% of the senior IT executives contacted said that skilled IT professionals are readily available compared to 66.5% last quarter. The July report from the Bureau of Labor Statistics noted a decrease of 2.9% from a year ago in employment within the sector covering ISPs and search portals. Telecommunications employment stabilized, dropping only 0.9% from July 2005. However, employment in computer and electronics manufacturing declined 8.2% reflecting softening demand and further industry consolidations.

Average compensation has increased only 4.8% from June of 2005 according to the CIO report and the Network World 2006 Salary Survey reported a base pay increase of 5.4%. Employers beware. Base salary was ranked fourth in importance as a factor in job satisfaction, but 11th in actual satisfaction. More than half (55%) of the network professionals surveyed are either actively looking or exploring. Worker confidence in the IT sector is up 4.3 points from last year according to the Hudson Employment Index.

If you're an IT professional, check all of your bases. Continuous evaluation and training is critical. Is your certification current or relevant to the market? Will a new certification help or do you just need to update the knowledge? Is your skill portfolio broad enough to cover project management and business process? Technical skills alone are no longer sufficient. Although the market for IT professionals is improving, real world experience along with additional training in applied skills such as Project Management are increasingly important.

If you're an IT manager, consider that opportunities are increasing for IT professionals and more are becoming confident about the future. A 2005 study by the American Society of Training and Development regarding certification reported: "Employers who pay attention to their employees through continous personal improvement, such as training and certifications, are more likely to see employees staying with that company." By training your staff to assume greater responsibilities and increase their skills and then rewarding them financially - productivity, profits, and above all retention will increase.

Certifications

Certification remains important, often as a differentiator between candidates. More relevant is that certification and continuing education provides a breadth of technical knowledge rather than what is specifically used on the job. However, technical proficiency is not enough for long-term success in the IT industry. According to a recent survey by the Society of Information Management, eight of the top 10 skills identified as critical to keep in-house were in business capabilities and project management. As reported in the CIO 2006 Midyear Staffing Update, 49% of the 269 IT executives surveyed were investing in project management training and 27% were allocating training budgets to business process management (more than one selection was available.)
